

By car: From Bristol A4: Approaching Bath along the dual carriageway, keep right and continue straight on through the traffic lights. Proceed 2.1 miles to **(A)**. Then follow the yellow route to the hospital as per the map.

From M4: Exit at junction 18 and take 1st exit onto the A46 signposted to Bath follow this for 7.7 miles. When the road goes under the Batheaston bypass flyover, exit left to the Bath roundabout. Take the 3rd exit on to the A4 and follow the Bath City Centre signs. Then follow the yellow route to the hospital as shown on the map from point **(B)**.

From Wells/Exeter A367: Enter Bath on the A367 and follow signs for the City Centre which takes you on to the Wells Road to point **(C)**. Then follow the yellow route to the hospital as shown on the map.

From Chippenham on the A4: Take the A4. Before the road goes under the Batheaston bypass flyover, exit left to the Bath roundabout. Take the 3rd exit on to A4 and follow the Bath City Centre signs. Then follow the yellow route to the hospital as shown on the map from **(B)**.

From Warminster on the A36: Enter Bath on the A36. Follow the yellow route to the hospital, shown on the map from **(D)**.

By train: Bath Spa train station is located in the centre of Bath, approximately half a mile from the hospital. There are regular train services direct from London, with an average journey time of around 90 minutes. Bristol Temple Meads is just 15 minutes away by train. There are taxis available from the front of the train station to the hospital.

By Park & Ride bus: Bath Park & Ride operates every 15 minutes all year round, from 6.15am - 8.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays (not Bank Holidays).

- Bus 31 - from Lansdown (north of city, 3 miles south of M4 J18) and drops off on Milsom Street.
- Bus 21 - from Newbridge (west of city on A4) and drops off on Monmouth Street.
- Bus 41 - from Odd Down (south of city on A367) and drops off on St James Parade.

By bus: The bus station is located approximately half a mile from the hospital adjacent to the train station.

Traveline provides timetables and journey planners for bus, coach and rail services in the South West. Traveline is available on tel. 0871 200 22 33 between 7.00 am and 10.00 pm (calls cost 10p per minute from landlines) or online www.traveline.info/index.html

FOR BLUE BADGE HOLDERS:

Parking in car parks: Designated easy access parking bays are available for blue badge holders in most city centre car parks. Charges apply in all Bath & North East Somerset Council car parks with the exception of the Sports Centre car park on North Parade.

On-street parking: There are designated disabled parking bays in the city centre marked on the map. These have white bay markings and the words '*Disabled parking*'. You can also park in Permit and Pay & Display on-street parking spaces without limit. When parking on-street you need to display your blue badge at all times.
